Tasting Notes

Beautiful nose of caramel and pineapple. Peach aroma with a hint of buttery pastry. Rich palate, opulent texture and solidly packed fruit. Substantial apple and pineapple flavors, but mostly ripe Chardonnay fruit flavors from the vineyard – very special to capture that same flavor!
